## Would your school like to grow wheat and make homegrown bread?

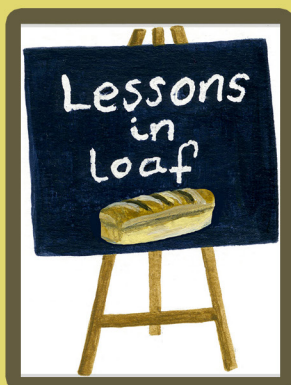
